## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in preparing the estimate of needs of the Sinking Fund of Tulsa County for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1934, estimated that 5% of the gasoline tax and automobile license fees would amount to the sum of \$12,835.88 and such sum was, by the Court of Tax Reviews of the State of Oklahoma, considered as income in determining the legal and necessary levy for the requirements of the aforesaid Sinking Fund for the aforesaid fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the estimated 5% of the aforesaid taxes will not produce the sum of \$12.835.88.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA OUNTY OKLAHOMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the County Treasurer of Tulsa County transfer from the funds of the County Highway Fund such amount as may be necessary to meet the difference between the actual receipts from such estimate received to date and the sum of \$12,835.88.
