WHEREAS, the Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to O. J. BRADY of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of Thirty and No/100 dollars (\$30.00) the following described lots:

AND WHEREAS, the sale of said lots by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 12755 of the compiled Statutes of Oklahoma of 1931, and amendments thereto, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by him at tax resale, and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given and published by the County Treasurer in the Tulsa Daily Legal News, the official paper of the County of Tulsa, that said County Treasurer would on this date apply to the Board of County Commissioners for an order approving said sale, and directing the issuance of deed therefor, and
