

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the following Resolution be approved, and all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Tulsa Stockyards, an Oklahoma corporation, has selected and designated a site for the construction of stock yards, a full description of said property being hereinafter fully set out, and

WHEREAS, the Regional Plan Commission of the city of Tulsa and vicinity as created by authority of sections 6158, 6159 and 6160 of Oklahoma Statutes 1931, upon submission to it by Tulsa Stockyards of its said proposed site, approved said proposed location in the following language, to-wit:

"That the Regional Plan Commission approve the proposed location of the stock yards in so far as the improvements in the immediate neighborhood are concerned, provided the same meets with the approval of the State Sanitary Engineer, particularly in so far as the pollution of the Arkansas River is concerned, and that this action be brought to the attention of the County Commissioners," and

WHEREAS, there is submitted to the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa ~~County~~ Oklahoma, evidence of the submission of said proposed site and location of said stock yards and a plat thereof, together with the approval of the Regional Plan Commission as above set out, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has duly considered the same.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in regular session on this 19th day of June, 1934, that the action of the Regional Plan Commission approving the site and location of Tulsa stock yards be and the same is hereby accepted and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the plat of said proposed site which embraces the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at the center of section 7, Township 19 North, Range 12 East and running east along the center line of said section 664.35 feet, thence north 1323 feet, thence west 664.35 feet to the center line of said section, thence south along said center line 1323 feet to the said center of the section, said tract being the whole of the West half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said section Seven (7), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, and a tract of land beginning at a point in the center line of section Seven, Township Nineteen North and Range Twelve East, 1323 feet north of the center of said section, running thence east 664.35 feet, thence north to the public highway, thence along the south line of said highway to the center line of said section, thence south along the center line of said section to the place of beginning, the said tract being all of that part of the West half of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Seven (7), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, lying on the south side of the public highway,

in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be accepted and approved and that the County Clerk of said County be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file and record the same as provided by law.
