Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that John Wallace be appointed Janitor at the Municipal Hospital as of March 10th, 1939, at a salary of \$45.00 per month. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Miller, Yes; Hopkins, Yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that Luther Mack who was janitor at the municipal hospital be appointed Orderly at said hospital as of March 10th, 1939 at a salary of \$50.00 per month. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Miller, Yes; Hopkins, Yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that W. K. Shackelford be and he is hereby appointed Watchman at the Tulsa County Farm & Home as of March 20th, 1939, at a salary of \$100.00 per month. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Miller, Yes; Hopkins, Yes. Motion carried.
