JULY 17th 1916. The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned session with all members present. There being bids advertised for the letting of a dwelling and barn on the County Farm, the bids being received were as follows:.

W.H.Fletcher being the lowest bidder, the contract was awarded to them. And he having filed his bond and contract, same being approved, he was ordered to proceed at once with the building as per plans and specifications furnished.
