

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that \$1,596 be allocated to the County Treasurer for the Welfare Department for the purchase of food stamps; said amount to be paid out of Q-3-A. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that \$404 be allocated to the Welfare Department for groceries. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that C. B. Jonas, Design Engineer, and <sup>C. K. Lawwill, Draftsman</sup> ~~Ex. Ex. Hathaway, Construction Engineer~~, be appointed in the Highway Department as of March 1st, 1942; Mr. Jonas salary to be \$300.00 per month and <sup>Mr. Lawwill</sup> ~~Mr. Hathaway~~ salary to be \$250.00 per month; said appointments are the recommendation of the County Engineer. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The matter of O. P. Kennon came on for hearing. Mr. Morley: I move that we approve the settlement between O. P. Kennon, Frank Apple and C. C. and George Hefele, that is, that Mr. Kennon agrees to pay \$33.00 each for an easement and that an easement will be drawn immediately between said parties. Motion seconded by Commissioner Greer, and upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that Paul Bray be placed in the construction gang as of February 1st, 1942, and that his salary be decreased from \$140.00 to \$100.00 per month as of said date.
