LEASE CONTRACT

THIS LEASE CONTRACT made this 1st day of October, 1945, by and between Southwest Machinery Co., called Lessor, and Tulsa County, Oklahoma, District No. 3, a municipal corporation acting by its Board of County Commissioners pursuant to a Resolution duly and legally adopted at a regular meeting on the first day of October, 1945, Lessee.

WITNESSETH:

Lessor, for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter mentioned to be kept and performed by the Lessee, does hereby lease and let to the Lessee the following described personal property:

One (1) Model #12, "Caterpillar" Motor Grader, serial No. 7T477

Lessee acknowledges receipt of said personal property in good order and condition, and upon the expiration of the term of this lease or sooner termination thereof Lessor shall be entitled to the immediate possession of said personal property, and the Lessee shall deliver said personal property to the Lessor at Tulsa, Oklahoma in good order and condition, ordinary wear and tear alone excepted.
