Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Hardesty, and unanimously carried, that the report filed by the Court Clerk, for the District Court Division for the month of June, 1949, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed.

Commissioner Hardesty brought up the question as to whether the Board of County Commissioners had the legal right to approve for payment the salary of the County Superintendent of Schools, since the last Legislature had changed the name of that Department from the County Superintendent of Public Instruction to the County Superintendent of Schools. Mr. Webster, the Assistance County Attorney, was called down to the Commission room for an opinion. He stated that <sup>in his opinion</sup> the Board would be within its legal right to approve this claim for payment, as the last Legislature merely changed the name and did not abolish the office.
