

COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL, TULSA COUNTY, OKLA.

Monday June 5th 1916.

The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma met in their rooms in the County Court House at 10: o'clock A.M. Present C.S.Avery, Chairman, Ed.Baker A.W.Lucas, and Lewis Cline, County Clerk.

The auditing of claims was first taken up after which the following motions were made,

Resolution
of FAIR
GROUND
ASS'N.

"Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners that they accept the bid of the TULSA FAIR GROUND ASSOCIATION for the sum of \$2235.00 cash in hand ,payment being the highest and best bid and being 100 % of the appraised value, and also it being shown that this was surplus ground not needed by the County for uses of Court House, Jail or County Home. It being further resolved that Tulsa Board of County Commissioners are hereby instructed to submit to the TULSA FAIR GROUND ASSOCIATION the proper deed, conveying all rights, titles, interest of the County of Tulsa to the above association, subject to any existing and valid oil and gas leases now on record.

The following is the resolution of County Commissioners previous to letting Bridge and Culvert Contracts.

RESOLUTION OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PRIMARY TO LETTING
BRIDGE AND CULVERT CONTRACTS.

The following resolution was thereupon proposed by Cyrus S.Avery, Chairman, and its adaption moved by him. The same was seccended by A.W.Lucas, Commissioner, and upon the vote being take, the same was adopted with the following vote::

Said resolution was as follows, to-wit:

Whereas it is the opinion of the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in meeting assemble, this 5th day of June 1916, that it is for the best interest of the County of Tulsa, and for the comfort and convenience of the citizens thereof, that permanent bridges and, (or) culverts should be built and constructed in Tulsa County, and WHEREAS, Plans and specifications for said bridges have been prepared and filed with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, for the bridges and (or) culverts hereinafter named and described.
NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa, County, construct, according to said plans and specifications, the following bridges, (or) culverts, more particularly, described as to location, materials, the approximate width of roadway, and depth of fill; the approximate length of span or arch; the approximate area of water shed to be drained by said bridges and (or) culverts, and the estimated costs of the same respectively, all as shown by the following schedule, to-wit:
