

The surveyors compilation and report on bids received for the construction of a drainage ditch in Park View Drainage District No. 2 presented, as hereinbefore set out upon motion by F. M. Wooden seconded by Ira Short, adopted, all members present voting "AYE" said compilation and report were accepted, and the contract for the construction of the said ditch was awarded to the Dahlstrom Construction Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma on their bid of \$33,737.76.

Said Dahlstrom Improvement Company having proposed to purchase the bonds of said district, at a price of par, accrued interest and a premium of \$500.00, in the event they be awarded the contract for the construction of said ditch, the bonds to be taken up and paid for as the Engineers Estimates are from time to time issued, and upon approval by their attorney, a certified transcript of all proceedings to be furnished for examination by such attorney, upon motion by F. M. Wooden seconded by Ira Short, adopted by all members voting "AYE" the said bonds were ordered sold to the said Dahlstrom Improvement Company, delivery to be made in accordance with said proposal.

Said Dahlstrom Improvement Company having presented the contract, construction and statutory bonds, duly approved by the Hughes Engineering Company, the surveyor, and John R. Woodard Attorney for the Park View Drainage District No. 2, upon motion by F. M. Wooden seconded by Ira Short adopted by all members voting "AYE", said contract, construction and statutory bond were approved by the board and ordered executed in quadruplicate by the said company and the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, the construction bond and duplicate contract to be filed and retained in the office of the county clerk, the statutory bond to be filed in the office of the Court Clerk, as provided by law, the contractor being present and having personal knowledge of the approval of said contract and bonds.

Upon motion of F. M. Wooden seconded by Ira Short, adopted, all members present voting "AYE" principals and sureties were released from further liability upon bond given December 5th, 1921, by resident land owners of Park View Drainage District No. 2, to secure payment of expenses in the event said ditch was not constructed.

A motion was made by Ira Short and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the certified check of Craig and Shaw, heretofore ordered held by the board, be returned. All members voting in the affirmative the motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

There being no further business coming before the Board for consideration on motion duly made and seconded the Board adjourned to Monday May 1st, 1922.
