RESOLUTION DESIGNATING ADDITIONAL COUNTY HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 44 of the Extraordinary Session of the Ninth Oklahoma Legislature provides, among other things, for the designation of County Highways, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of Tulsa County that a certain road be made a part of the County Highway System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that

The Section line between Sections 11-12, 13-14 and
23-24, Twp. 21 N., Range 13 E., locally known as
Dalton Hill Road

be and the same is hereby designated as a County Highway.

All members voting in the affirmative, motion was declared and resolution adopted.
