Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that we advertise for bids on the repair of the shed roof of the County Hospital, and that the County Clerk be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to give 10 days notice thereof.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the County Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids on the old photostat machine.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, that a recess be taken until the hour of 10:00 O'clock Monday, October 27, 1947.
