NOW, On this the 24th. day of June, 1929, the matter of the Petition of the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company for permission to lay an underground conduit line along certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Southwestern Bell Telephone Company be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Company, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of Yale and Admiral Street, Tulsa, Oklahoma, East along the North side of paved road on Admiral Place or Federal Drive 1 mile, or to the Sheridan Road. Approximately 5200' of underground conduit and construct 11 manholes, Section 3, Township 19, North, Range 13 East.
