## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, for the purpose of constructing a highway through and across a certain parcel of land in Section Ten (10), Township Seventeen (17), North, Range Thirteen (13) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, it is necessary to acquire an EASEMENT across said parcel of land, more particularly described as follows:
