MONDAY, APRIL 3rd, 1939.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, April 3rd, 1939, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with the following members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray, Member. Andy Stokes, County Clerk. Harry L. Hopkins, member, absent.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the report filed by Andy Stokes, County Clerk, for the month of March, 1939, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the report filed by A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff, for Board of Prisoners for the month of March, 1939, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the Chairman be authorized to execute a Quit Claim Deed on Lot 10, Block 1; Lot 2, Block 2; Lots 10 & 11, Block 5; Lots 1-13 & 14, Block 11 and Lots 8 & 9, Block 12, all in Eastmoor Park Addition, Tulsa, Oklahoma, to the present owner of said property for the reason that said property was sold in error; all taxes having been paid prior to the date of the re-sale. Motion carried.
