The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa Co. met in the County Clerk's office with the following Members present. W. L. North - M. L. Sanders and James Woolley. Absent none. Motion by Chairman to make M. L. Sanders temporary Chairman. Motion Carried and so declared.

Upon Motion of Mr North and Seconded by Woolley, M. L. Sanders was made permanent Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners for the year 1911.

The first matter of Bus. taken up was with reference to the amount necessary to complete Bridge No. 52. and after due consideration, it was moved by Mr North and Seconded by Mr Woolley to add 5000⁰⁰ to the Contract price on said Bridge for completion. The motion Carried Unanimously. - In the matter of Contracts for County Printing, the bids were opened and read as follows:-

Gentlemen:- In consideration of being named as the official paper and being given all publications the same as the past year, we will publish all matter paid for by the County for One dollar per year. Other matter such as delinquent tax list and not ultimately paid by the County, to be as the law provides at legal rates all above publications to go in daily or weekly or both as may be designated.
