Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the Cattle Brand (Drag K) filed by Mrs. Mollie L. King, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
