Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the bid made on Eot 1, Block 79, Original Town of Collinsville and Lot 1, Block 3, East Park Addition to Collinsville, by Joe Schuman in the total amount of \$46.00, be and the same is hereby rejected. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner G ray, that the bid made by Earl B. Schuman in the total amount of \$105.00 on $W_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ Lot 14, Block 58, 0.T. of Collinsville, be and the same is hereby rejected.
