SUPERVISION:

The Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College will supervice the work of these agents, carefully looking after the same to see that the work is done efficiently and in a manner to be of the largest possible benefit to the people of the œunty, and to pay the expenses of the agents when they are authorized to attent meetings outside of the county on official business.

SPECIAL AID:

The said A. & M. College likewise to send to the county special representatives to assist these agents on special tasks, and to hold educational meetings for the benefit of farmers and to assist in every possible way in making the work in the county effective.

PAYMENT OF SALARY:

The Agent's salary will be payable on or after the first of each month on certificate from the agent that the work has been duly performed.

CHANGE OF AGENTS:

In case of any dissatisfaction with the work of the agent, on the part of the A. & M. College or on the part of the County Commissioners each shall notify the other party of such dissatisfaction and if the dissatisfaction cannot be removed and all parties fully satisfied, said agent shall be promptly removed. If an agent is removed by agreement between the parties, another competent and satisfactory agent shall be selected to continue the work to the completion of the contract in the same manner as originally provided.
