J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the proposal, plans and specifications for the paving and otherwise improving of that portion of Memorial Boulevard lying between Section 11 & 12 and 13 & 14, T 20 N, R 13 E, in Mohawk Park from a junction with U.S. 169 southwardly a distance of 1.013 miles, at an estimated cost of \$34,484.09, be and the same are hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to advertise for bids to be received until 9 o'clock A.M., April 6th, 1942, said advertisements to be given to the Newspaper Printing Corporation, and to run for two consecutive weeks. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
