

such right-of-way, and the moving, lowering, encasing and rearranging of such public utility facilities as are necessary to accomodate construction of such projects, and to pay all costs of such right-of-way and clearing of obstructions and utilities out of County Highway Funds.

AND THAT the Board of County Commissioners of said County will maintain all projects constructed with such Federal and State Trust Funds on said Secondary Highway Program which are not on a designated State or Federal Highway in a manner satisfactory to the State Highway Commission, with the necessary amount from the county Highway cash funds or special budget account.

Adopted this 15th day of October, 1945, by the unanimous vote of said Board of County Commissioners.
