Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Commercial Gas Contract between the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company and the Board of County Commissioners covering Tulsa County Court House and Tulsa County Farm, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the following resolution be adopted, to-wit:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, THE OKLAHOMA GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, under date of October 8th, 1945, has made application for the use of certain highways of Tulsa County, for the purpose of transmitting and selling electricity for light, heat and power purposes, and

WHEREAS, it appears that said Company is entitled under the laws to use the said highways for such purposes, and whereas, it appears that the use of such highways will not interfere with, or impede traffic and that such service is at this time demanded by customers to be served by said line.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Board of County Commissioners, in regular meeting, do hereby give our consent to the use of the following highways in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, by the Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, its successors and assigns, for the purpose of transmitting and selling electric current, said highway being more particularly described as follows:
