The Petition of the Oklahoma Union Traction Co. to cross the highways in Tulsa county in extending their lines from Tulsa to Sapulpa. Said Traction Company agrees to leave all crossing in good condition and to maintain such crossings and not to construct or operate its ^{line} upon and parallel to any highway for more than 200 ft. without the consent of this Board of Commissioners.

Be it Ordained ^{and decreed} by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa Co. That the right and privilege is hereby granted to the Oklahoma Union Traction Co. a Corporation organized and existing under the laws of Oklahoma to construct, maintain and operate its line of road across and over any and all highways that it may desire in constructing and operating its line from Tulsa to Sapulpa in the State of Oklahoma.

The said traction Company is at no point to construct or operate its lines upon and parallel to the wagon road or any highway for more than two hundred feet without the consent of this Board of Commissioners duly made upon petition from said company and showing reason why it cannot construct its line of road across any highway it may seek to cross in constructing its road as aforesaid.
