WHEREAS, it appears that a reorganization of the said Fair Board and the adoption of suitable rules and regulations as above described will require a considerable time and could probably not be accomplished in time to conduct a fair at the proper season during this year, and

WHEREAS, a financial and economic emergency of considerable proportions exists within the County, making doubtful the wisdom of appropriating a large amount of money for a Free Fair in or for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, during the year 1934 in the face of the present need for moneys for charitable purposes, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as follows, to-wit:

That no appropriation or budget of moneys be made, allowed or approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the purpose of conducting a Free Fair in 1934 by virtue of the act above described, to-wit: Chapter 159 of the Session Laws of Oklahoma, 1925.
