The Board further found that a lawful majority of the qualified electors voting in said election cast their ballot in favor of the Improvement District. It is therefore ordered that said Sewer Improvement District #2 be and the same is hereby finally established. The Board further found that said Sewer Improvement District having been lawfully created a Board of Directors for such Improvement District was required and the following three men were designated by the Board to serve as the Board of Directors for the next two succeeding years and until their respective successors shall be appointed and qualified: I. A. Jacobson - Director, Ben O. Kirkpatrick, Clerk, Russell M. Jacobson, Member, The Board further found each of said perons were land owners within the Sewer Improvement District and therefore eligible to accept such appointment. Said Board having been duly and lawfully appointed is hereby directed to formulate all by-laws, rules and regulation that shall be necessary for the full protection, maintainance, management and control of the sewerage system of said district including the lines of conveyance, plants and other property used in connection therewith and said Board is further authorized and directed to proceed as the employment of a registered and professional engineer to prepare profiles, plans and specifications of work together with a complete estimate of the cost, and upon receipt of such data the Board is authorized and directed to advertise for sealed bids for the performance of the work in connection with the construction of said sewer system, and said Board of Directors is hereby further authorized and directed to proceed further with the formation, management and control of said Sewer Improvement District in the manner and form prescribed by law.
