

March 6 - 1911.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular monthly session in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County for the purpose of taking up all matters to come before them. Those present were H. Sanders, Chairman. James Woolley and W. L. North - Absent None.

The first matter taken up was with reference to repairing the County Bridge across the Arkansas River. It was decided to begin repairing the bridge on the 9th day of March and the County Clerk was authorized to publish the following in the three newspapers.

Notice

For the purpose of repairing the County Bridge across the Ark River the bridge will be closed each day from 8 to 12 A.M. and from 1 to 5 P.M. beginning Thursday March 9 - 1911. Signed H. L. Sanders James Woolley & W. L. North.

The Clerk was asked to call up a few of the lumber dealers and get bids on about 40 M feet of 2x12x16 #2.

Motion made to accept the Bond of the Skiatook Bank as a County depository in the sum of \$5000.00 carried and the Clerk instructed to inform the Treasurer of same.

The claims as recorded in the Claim book were acted on as shown by the said record.

Motion made to adjourn to 1 o'clock P.M. carried.

The Commissioners reconvened at 1 o'clock P.M.

Motion made to adopt the following resolution as part of the resolutions.

Now on this 6th day of March 1911 The Commissioners of Tulsa County Oklahoma being duly and legally in session, J. R. League is by a member of this Board nominated as judge of the Superior court of Tulsa County Oklahoma and John E. Wells is nominated as clerk of the Superior court of Tulsa County Oklahoma and on a vote of this Board, said persons are by a majority vote of this Board selected for the respective offices to wit; J. R. League as judge of the Superior court of Tulsa County Oklahoma, & John E. Wells as clerk of the Superior court of Tulsa County Oklahoma. & said persons are hereby appointed as such officers, and their appointments to such offices hereinbefore made is hereby ratified and confirmed and the Bond of said Court filed on the 16th day of January 1911. By John E. Wells is approved. Carried and copied in the Minutes.

Motion made and carried that the report of viewers on the Drainage of Dist #2 be accepted - Carried Unanimously and the Clerk ordered to spread the same on the Minutes -
