

MONDAY, JANUARY 6th, 1941.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, January 6th, 1940, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: G. H. Shepard, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Lincoln Sallee, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

G. H. Shepard, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley that Jack Neal, Carl Porter, Ted White and L. C. Wilder, employees in the County Highway Department, be dismissed as of January 1st, 1941, and that E. A. Herbig, J. D. McMullin, Chester Pennell and D. C. Thatcher be employed in their places as of January 1st, 1941. Motion seconded by Commissioner Sallee, and upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Shepard, seconded by Commissioner Sallee, that H. H. Snow be dismissed as of January 1st, 1941 and that Bob Melton be appointed in his place as of January 1st, 1941. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that \$1,000 be allocated to the Welfare Department for groceries for the month of January, 1941. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
