Moved by Dick, seconded by Harris, to approve the contract with the Tulsa United States Slowpitch Softball Association for the organizing the coming spring softball season at Haikey Creek Park. Upon roll call, Dick, yes; Harris, yes. Motion carried. (Clerk's Misc. File No. 151998)

Bales discussed his March 16 memo regarding golf course cart rental and driving range fee increases. Moved by Dick, seconded by Harris, to approve the cart rental fee for 18 holes from \$16.00 + tax to \$17.00 + tax and cart rental fee for 9 holes from \$8.50 + tax to \$9.00 + tax and driving range (30 ball token) from \$1.50 to \$2.00, effective April 1, 1994. Upon roll call, Dick, yes; Harris, yes. Motion carried. This increase was recommended by Jerry Jones and the Park Advisory Board.
