

TUESDAY, AUGUST 16, 1949

The Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M. with the following members present: John Couch, Chairman; J. W. Hardesty, Member; Claude W. Bailey, Member; Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John Couch, Chairman, presiding, the following business was transacted.

Mr. Holley L. Anderson, Attorney, submitted a Petition of approximately 70 per cent of the property owners in Water Improvement District No. 10, whose signatures appeared thereon, requesting the removal of the present Board of Directors and the appointment of new Directors in said District. Mr. W. L. Eagleton, Attorney, for the District, presented a Petition signed by 104 residents living in the District, requesting the Board of County Commissioners not to disrupt the present Board of Directors or change the members of the Board. After Mr. Anderson and Mr. Eagleton had presented their arguments to the Board, a motion was made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Hardesty, that no change be made in the present Directors of Water Improvement District No. 10, at the present time. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that upon the recommendation of the County Attorney's office, the following claims covering additional compensation at the rate of \$50.00 per month from March 2, 1949 up to June 1, 1949, as provided by House Bill 141 recently passed by the State Legislature, and signed by the Governor on March 2, 1949, granting an increase in salaries to the Bailiffs of the Court of Common Pleas, be approved for payment, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to issue warrants covering same.
