

The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa Co. Okla. being in regular Session a Petition for the establishment and construction of a drain or improvement was presented to said Board. It appearing to said that the proper Bond has been filed with the said Petition with the County Clerk, conditioned for the payment of all costs, if the prayer of the petition be not granted or be dismissed for any cause, The same is hereby by this Board approved.

The Board of County Commissioners hereby appoints - John I. Kramen - and E. J. Peoples, and M. F. Smith Three resident freeholders of this County, not interested in the construction of said work, and not of kin to any person interested therein, as Viewers and also directs R. K. Hughes, Surveyor to assist the Viewers so appointed to view the line of the proposed drain or improvement and report by actual view of the premises along and adjacent thereto, whether the proposed drain or improvement is practicable and necessary or, of private or public utility and benefit. They shall also report and recommend the best route for the proposed drain or improvement, whether any portion of the same should be covered or abridged, and whether the work of constructing the same should be allotted to the several interests, or be let by contract without allotment, and shall make their report in writing to the County Clerk, who shall enter the same upon the records of this body. Said Viewers shall before entering upon their duties, take and subscribe an oath faithfully and impartially to discharge their duties as such Viewers and truly and correctly to make and return their report herein required.
