

MONDAY NOVEMBER 29TH, 1943

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman, Curtis Greer and Robt. L. Kinkaid, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the following affidavits of erroneous assessments filed and approved by Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, be and the same are hereby approved, to-wit:

Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Mr. R. D. Boyd, Route 7 Box 121 B, Tulsa, Oklahoma, be allowed to attach on to the water line owned by Tulsa County supplying the Tulsa County Farm. It is agreed that the tap not be larger than three-quarter inch. It is also agreed that anyone desiring to attach on to Mr. Boyd's line must pay to Tulsa County \$150.00 for each tap. Receipt for \$150.00 paid to the Tulsa County Treasurer on this 29th day of November, 1943, is hereby accepted and filed. Receipt No. 23256. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, to raise the salaries of C. M. Murphree, Meter Reader and Supervisor of Maintenance of the Lines and Neva Robinson, Assistant Clerk, in Water Improvement District No. 3, from \$100.00 per month to \$125.00 per month, as of September 1, 1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the following claims be approved and warrants issued to cover. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken. Commissioner Gray, No; Commissioner Greer, Aye; Commissioner Kinkaid, Aye. Motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
