R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, there has for the last several years and there now exists in Tulsa County a Highway Patrol comprised of special officers or patrolmen as Peace Officers to patrol public highways, as provided by Chapter 194, Session Laws of 1923, duly commissioned by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed for the best interests that said Highway Patrol, continue to function and operate as such, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that said Highway Patrol be provided with all necessary equipment to properly regulate and enforce the provisions of said Chapter 194, Session Laws of 1923, including automobiles and radio equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the provision for said Highway Patrol be and the same is hereby confirmed and ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an adequate number of special officers to patrol public Highways in Tulsa County be commissioned, their salaries to be provided for by appropriations to be made for that purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Highway Patrol be supplied with necessary automobiles and radio equipment for use in enforcing the provisions of said Chapter 194 Session Laws of 1923, the cost and maintenance of same to be provided for by appropriations to be made for that purpose.
