

MONDAY, OCTOBER 29, 1945

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock a. m., with following members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman. Curtis Greer and Claude W. Bailey, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that upon the recommendation of A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff, Clyde Blakely be dismissed as night jailor, effective November 1, 1945. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that upon the recommendation of A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff, the appointment of E. V. Freeman, as night jailor effective October 26th, 1945, at a salary of \$175.00 per month, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
