

Thursday, October 23, 1986

The Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County, Oklahoma met at the hour of 9:00 a.m., with the following members present: John Selph, Chairman; Melvin C. Rice, Member; and Lewis Harris, Member. Members absent: None. Others present: Susan Morgan, Clay Edwards, Melody Bishop, and Bekki Martin with the Tribune.

Terry Simonson was present to discuss the Dispute Resolution. The Board discussed a proposed draft of an agreement between the County and the City and the Resolution Resources of Oklahoma to provide dispute resolution services to the City and County. Susan Morgan is to re-draft the agreement for Board approval at a later date.

Tom Lester, Tulsa Area Emergency Management Agency, was present to discuss requests and recommendations regarding sirens and sensors. Tom Lester stated it would cost \$500 each to have the sirens removed from their present location and be placed in populated areas near cities and towns.
