

Motion was made by Commissioner Wooden, seconded by Commissioner Short, that the Petition of the F.G. Telephone Line owners be granted and that the Petitioners be permitted to change their line. This permission is granted with the understanding that this change be made under the supervision of the County Engineer. The Petition in detail follows:

P E T I T I O N.

We, the undersigned, owners and operators of the F.G. Telephone Line, do hereby petition the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, for permission and authority to establish, maintain and operate our rural telephone line from a point midway between 17th. Street and Buena Vista Avenue and the intersection of Lewis Avenue; south on Lewis Avenue to 21st. Street, thereby connecting up with the present F.G. Line at the intersection of 21st. Street and Lewis Avenue. If permitted to make this change in their route, the F.G. Telephone Line will discontinue their present route along 21st. Street and Utica Avenue to the intersection of 19th. Street and Utica Avenue, as it is now established, and thereby shorten the line a distance of 3/8 miles.

Motion was made by Commissioner Short, seconded by Commissioner Wooden, that the County Clerk be instructed to inform Mr. R.T. Daniels that the Board of County Commissioners will grade and make a passable road, if he will make a Deed to Right of Way for a 50 foot road to the Board of County Commissioners. This right of way is to extend north and South on Birmingham Street, formerly known as Cleland Avenue which is located in Section 5, Township 19, Range 13.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wooden, seconded by Commissioner Short, that the County Engineer be instructed to furnish an estimated approximate cost of paving the Red Fork road, a twenty seven foot roadway, and also an estimate in connection with this, to furnish approximate cost of disposition of water that originates at what is known as Howard Park, and furnish the Commissioners with information as to whether the City or County is supposed to take care of this water. This motion was amended as follows: Ask County Engineer to furnish approximate cost of eighteen foot road way, with six foot shoulders, to be constructed with the materials now on the ground.

Motion was made by F.M. Wooden, seconded by Ira Short, that the matter of Erroneous Assessment in behalf of L.E.Z. Aronson, as presented by Mr. Burns be continued until May 23rd. 1922, at 2:00 o'clock P.M.

There being no further business the Board adjourned, to meet at 2:00 o'clock May 23rd. 1922.
