MONDAY, AUGUST 29, 1949

Pursuant to a recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock a. m., with the following members present: John Couch, Chairman; J. W. Hardesty, Member; Claude W. Bailey, Member and Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John Couch, Chairman, presiding the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Couch, seconded by Commissioner Hardesty, and unanimously carried, that the Final Estimate of the Standard Paving Company on Projects 2-m, 2-E and 2-C Extension, in the total amount of \$9,316.40, be, and the same is hereby approved for payment.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Hardesty, and unanimously carried, that the Final Estimate of the H. D. Youngman Contractor, Inc. on Project S-318 (2) in the total amount of \$8,691.62, be, and the same is hereby approved for payment.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Hardesty, and unanimously carried, that the Final Estimate of H. D. Youngman Contractor, Inc. on Project S-318 (3) in the total amount of \$3,589.38, be, and the same is hereby approved for payment.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$11,480.55, and the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for appropriation for the County Highway Restricted SU Cash Fund in the amount of \$6,080.82, be, and the same are hereby approved, and the Chairman is hereby authorized and instructed to execute same and submit them to the Excise Board for their consideration.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Hardesty, that the Abstractor's Bond in the amount of \$5,000 filed by J. Lacy Ballanger Abstract Company and made by the Continental Casualty Company, be, and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call motion carried

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Hardesty, that the Report filed by Water Improvement District No. 10 from March 31 to June 30, 1949, be, and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, motion carried

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Couch, that the application for a cattle brand ① "OD" on right hip of cattle, filed by O. L. Davenport, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the appointment of Robert D. Simms, as a deputy in the office of the Court Clerk, effective as of August 15, 1949, at a salary of \$200.00 per month, be, and the same is hereby approved.
