The undersigned, being familiar with the Standard Specifications of the State of Oklahoma respecting the construction of Highways by bringing to profile grade, etc., and being familiar with the location and character of the work to be done, and performed in the grading of the Owasso-Sperry County Highway, known as Miles Eight (8) and Nine (9) of Section "E", hereby proposes to furnish all labor, materials and equipment and to do the said work in each and every particular according to the slopes, stakes,
