

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 31, 1949

Pursuant to a recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock a. m. today, with the following members present: John Couch, Chairman; J. W. Hardesty, Member; Claude W. Bailey, Member, and Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John Couch, Chairman, presiding, the following business was transacted.

Upon the instructions of the Chairman, the following sealed bids for the furnishing of materials and the performance of all labor required in the erection and completion of the new heating system for the present Dunbar School located in Tulsa, were opened and read -

Palmer Plbg. & Heating Co. for the sum of \$59,557.74, Alternate #1 in the amount of \$7,500.00, together with certified check for \$6,000.00.

Watt Plbg. Air Conditioning and Electric Co. for the sum of \$48,213.00, Alternate #1 in the amount of \$2,395.00, together with certified check for \$6,000.00/

Howerton Plumbing Co. in the sum of \$40,939.34, Alternate #1 in the amount of \$3,379.52, together with certified check for \$4,092.94.

American Plumbing & Heating Co., for the sum of \$46,711.00, Alternate #1 in the amount of \$6,350.00, together with Bid Bond in the amount of \$5,500.00.

J. L. Heath Co., for the sum of \$49,985.00, Alternate #1 in the amount of \$2,750.00, together with Bid Bond covering 10% of the amount of the bid.

After all Bids were opened and read, a motion was made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Contract for the erection and completion of the new heating system for the present Dunbar School, be, and is hereby awarded to the low Bidder. Upon roll call, motion unanimously carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that certified checks accompanying the Bids from Palmer Plumbing & Heating Company, Watt Plumbing Air Conditioning & Electric Company, Howerton Plumbing Company, American Plumbing & Heating Company and J. L. Heath Company, on the erection and completion of the heating system for Dunbar School/ <sup>be returned.</sup> Upon roll call, motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that Tuesday, October 4, 1949, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock a. m., be set for the accepting of bids on the portable equipment for the Booker T. Washington High School, and that the County Clerk is authorized to publish notice as required by law. Upon roll call, motion carried.
