FRIDAY, APRIL 21st, 1939.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry E. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that E. E. Delo, deputy Sheriff and night jailor, be given a leave of absence as of April 21st, 1939, without pay. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by E. R. Brenneman, agent, covering real estate for the years 1931 and 1932, be and the same is hereby approved at a 65% reduction and the County Clerk is directed to issue a certificate of error covering same, provided, however, that the certificate of error shall not be issued until the expiration of twenty days from the date of this order and, provided further, that said certificate of error shall not be issued if any protest be filed within said twenty days until the issue of said protest is determined. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the Chairman be authorized to execute a warranty deed to the Hillside Cemetery Association, Inc., as per cemetery patent filed in the office of the County Clerk on October 6th, 1914, Book 169, Page 467. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

WHEREUPON, a recess is hereby taken until Friday, April 28th, 1939, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M.
