The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County Okla. met in regular Session in the Co. Clerk's Office with the following members present - W. L. Sanders, Chairman, and Mr. S. North. Absent James Woolley. Mr. Woolley came in at 10³⁰.

The first matter of bus. was auditing claims against the County, of which a record of same will be found in the Claim Record as acted on by the County Board.

In the matter of road petitions of Wekiwa Twp. of which there were two, one filed by John Haden and one by L. D. Lindsay regarding a road in Wekiwa Twp. Both petitions were recalled and taken back for a more complete petition.

In the matter of C. A. Steel regarding the assessment of taxes on restricted land. The affidavit was accepted and motion made and seconded to strike same from the rolls for yrs. 1908-1909-1910 Carried.

Motion made to allow the claim of Mr. Nesbitt for \$100.00 for one acre of ground for colored school purposes and to hold the warrant until the deed was received - Carried.

Moved and seconded that the claim of Mr. Breckinridge for salary as judge of the Superior Court be disallowed - Carried.

Motion made and seconded to disallow Mr. Clines claim as Clerk of the Superior Court - Carried.

The above motions were made on request of Judge and Clerk.
