described lands on the 7th day of December, 1943, with working crews, tools and machinery, and proceed to construct, finish and complete said proposed improvements thereon, and said Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12 will save and hold the United States of America harmless against all claims or damages by reason of such entry, and said district has the legal right to make such guarantee.

Upon motion by Commissioner Greer, and seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, a vote was had thereon, and the Chairman declared said resolution unanimously adopted.
