Now on this 4th day of April the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County Okla. being in regular session, the matter of granting an easement and franchise of certain petitioners petitioning for the granting of the privileges of constructing a telephone line a long a portion of the public highway, said petition being in writing and signed by John I. Kramer and others, the Board being fully advised in the premises finds that the prayer of said petitioners should be allowed, and it is so ordered that an easement and franchise be granted by said Board to said petitioners permitting them to construct, operate & maintain a telephone line along the public highway as follows:

Beginning at a point in the public highway at the Southeast corner of the Corporation limits of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the range line between
