MONDAY, JULY 31, 1989


The Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County met at the hour of 9:15 a.m. with the following members present: John Selph, Chairman; Melvin C. Rice, Member; Lewis Harris, Member; and Marie Smith, Secretary representing the County Clerk's office.

John Selph, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:20 a.m. and the following business was transacted:

A Public Hearing for the purpose of receiving citizen recommendations on community development needs within the unincorporated portions of Tulsa County was called to order at 9:20 a.m. Rich Brierre, INCOG, was present and stated the purpose of this program was to assist low income neighborhoods. The CDBG applications must be submitted to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by August 31, 1989. Harris stated he would like to again submit a request for improvements and extensions to the Turley water distribution system. Selph would like to submit a grant for an area near Charles Page Blvd. Selph asked if anyone present wished to speak on community development needs. Nelson Sager was present and spoke about the water problem in Turley. He works for the Turley Volunteer Fire Dept. and stated they cannot fight fires due to the lack of water. Said they have lost five houses during the last year due to this problem. Hearing closed at 9:30 a.m. (Clerk's Misc. File No. 128079)

Moved by Selph, seconded by Rice, that this meeting be adjourned. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Rice, yes; Selph, yes. Motion carried.
