Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with ~~allixme~~ the following members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer, member. Andy Stokes, County Clerk. Ralsa F. Morley, absent on account of illness.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the bid received April 6th, 1942, on the improvement of Memorial Boulevard, lying between Section 11 and 12, and 13 and 14, Twp. 20N, Range 13E, in Mohawk Park, from a junction with U.S. 169, southwardly a distance of approximately one mile in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and made by the Standard Paving Company, be and the same is hereby accepted, same being the lowest bid received. Bid being in the amount of \$34,356.80 and approved by the County Attorney. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Statutory Bond, Performance Bond and Contract filed by the Standard Paving Company on project No. 2, which covers the paving and otherwise improving of Memorial Boulevard from U.S. 169 southwardly approximately one mile in Mohawk Park, in the amount of \$34,356.80, be and the same are hereby approved and the County Engineer is hereby instructed to issue work orders. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by Edward F. Jones, Clerk, Court of Common Pleas, for the month of March, 1942, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.
