The Board of County Commissioners, at a regular meeting of said Board held on the 4th day of April 1911. It was regularly moved and seconded that the tax case pending in the Circuit Court of the U.S. for the Eastern District of Okla. wherein the Atchison-Topeka and Santa Fe Ry. Company is Complainant and H. J. Richardson et al. Defendants be compromised as per stipulations to be filed in said Court in said cause by said parties. The Basis of compromise to be as follows - to wit:

The Complainant to pay the said Defendants in full settlement of the taxes due upon the property of said Complainant in Tulsa County, for the year 1908 the sum of \$1564.²⁰ and the said Complainant to pay in full settlement of its taxes due on Complainant's property all the taxes for the year 1909 as they appear upon the Books of the Treasurer of said County without penalty. The said Complainant by its attorney appearing and accepting the said terms of compromise.

The Motion above referred to was regularly and duly passed and the County Attorney, Pak Malloy, for Tulsa County - Authorized and empowered to enter into a stipulation and agreement with said Complainant Company upon the terms and conditions aforesaid. Said payment to be made within (15) fifteen days.

Mr North as purchasing agent was instructed to look into the benefits of a Cash Register and if in his judgment he thought best to purchase same.

Motion made to adjourn to first Monday in May by Mr Woolley and seconded by Mr North. Carried.
