The Board of County Commissioners met in regular monthly session in the County Clerk Office with the following members present N. L. Sanders Chairman, W. L. North & James Woolley - Absent none.

The first matter of Bus. taken up was Auditing the various Claims Against the County a record of which can be found in the Claim Record, together with the Boards Action Thereon.

With reference to Changes in the Court House plans, Motion was made by Mr North, That Plate glass be used instead of plain glass & Marble instead of Cement for Risers & Treads, & Gyp. tile be used instead for partitions instead of Steel lath & Cement. & Extra Colored Gules Marble Wainscoting, & White Marble Floor instead of Tile - Approximately \$9,731.⁰⁰ Seconded by Mr Woolley & same Carried.

Motion made & seconded to appoint N. L. Gregory Clerk of Jenks Township - Carried.

Motion made & seconded to accept the Resignation of Mr Wulff as justice of the peace at Jenks - Carried.

Motion made & seconded to appoint J. W. Beck justice of the Peace of Owasso Twp. Same was Carried.

Motion made & seconded to appoint Mr Givens as justice of Peace of Owasso Township - Same Carried.

As to Various Applications ^{bids} for filling approaches to six Bridges in Boulev & Fry Twp. On opening the bids the bid of A. C. Hays was accepted & Mr N. L. Sanders Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners was Authorized to enter into Contract for same Bid 12³/₄ ^{cts} per cu. yd. Motion made to Adjourn until 9 A. M. Tues - 5-2-1911
