

The following petition was received -

Application of the Phoenix Refining Company for leave to use highways for Pipe lines.

To The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa Co. Okla.

Comes now the Phoenix Refining Company a Corporation organized under the laws of the State of Okla. and respectfully shows the Commissioners that it proposes to engage in the business of Refining oil at Sand Springs Okla. a Station on the M.K. & T. Railroad, Approximately Seven (7) miles from the City of Tulsa & in Tulsa County Okla.

That in order to properly carry on said Bus. It is necessary for this Company to transport oil from oil wells within the County of Tulsa & distant from its plant at said Sand Springs. That the oil so used is ordinarily transported in pipe lines laid in, along & across highways & Public roads within said County.

The Company prays from the Commissioners leave to lay such Pipe lines as may be necessary for the transportation of Oil as aforesaid in & along & over the Highways and Public Roads of the County of Tulsa; Said Pipes to be laid at the Expense of the County & to conform with the Grade of the Road or highways & under the Supervision & Subject to the direction of the County Commissioners & so laid and maintained as not to interfere with the use of said Highways or Road and within three feet of the Outer boundary of the road or highway so used.
