

to use and occupy the Highways and Roads of Tulsa Co for the laying and maintaining of Pipe lines for the conveying of oil to its Refinery at Sand Spring Okla. Such Pipe lines to be laid within (3) three feet of the outer boundary of the Public Highway so used, so as to correspond with the Grade of the Highways and Roads and so as not to interfere with the ordinary use thereof. The Laying and maintaining of said pipe lines, to be under the Supervision and Subject to the direction of the County Commissioners and at the Expense of the Refining Company.

Motion made to accept the Resignation of Claude Sample as Justice of the Peace of Bixby Township - Seconded & same was carried.

Motion made to appoint W. H. Wilcox as Justice of the Peace of Bixby Township - Seconded & same carried.

A Delegation of Citizens met with the County Commissioners in reference to opening a right of way from Dr. Kennedy's Residence, West - Black Dog Turn - of Osage County. Agreed to donate \$500.00. Wekiwa Turn was also willing to donate \$500.00 toward the building the road in question and asked the County Commissioners to declare an emergency and build a Bridge on the Osage line running East and West, to enable the public a right of way to reach the City of Tulsa.

Mr. Kennedy agreed to donate (30) thirty feet and the City Board agreed to donate (30) thirty feet, making a road (60) sixty feet in width.

The County Commissioners were favorable to the above proposition and asked for bids for constructing bridge along said road and in opening the bids - namely - The Oklahoma Iron works and The Tulsa Boiler and Mfg Co. The Tulsa Boiler and Manufacturing Co's bid was accepted on the Steel work, the Balance consisting of the wood work and Concrete work was to be arranged later.

The Amount of the Tulsa Boiler and Mfg. Co's bid being \$564.00
