

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the proposal, plans and specifications for the furnishing of materials and performing the work necessary to be done in the paving of pine Street, West of Harvard Ave., to Sheridan Road, a distance of approximately 2.224 miles, at an estimated cost of \$79,589.76, be and the same are hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to advertise for bids to be received until 9 o'clock A.M., April 27th, 1942, said advertisement to be given to the Newspaper Printing Corporation, and to run for two consecutive weeks. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

There has been presented to this Board an application or petition to vacate a certain portion of Twenty-Second Street described as follows:

Twenty-Second Street from the east line of Florence Street to the east line of Wilshire Manor, an addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, lying entirely between blocks one and seven in said Wilshire Manor, an addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

WHEREAS, the said petition has been properly signed by twelve freeholders residing in the vicinity of said street so to vacate. It is ordered that notice be given for twenty days setting forth said facts and that said hearing will be heard and said petition acted upon on the 18th day of May, 1942, at which time any person desiring to make objections thereto may be present.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that a quit claim deed be issued to H. W. McDonnold covering Lot 18, Block 1, University Place Addition to the City of Tulsa, for the reason that said property was sold in error, said taxes having been paid prior to the date of the re-sale, according to the County Treasurer. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by Chairman declared carried.
