NOW, On this the 19th. day of August, 1929, the matter of the petition of the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company for permission to lay an underground conduit line along certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Southwestern Bell Telephone Company be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Company, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

To construct one manhole at the Southwest Corner of the intersection of 51st. Street and South Lewis Avenue and to place underground laterals 180' North 148' East, 180' West and 68' Southeast to Light Company's Pole. Laterals to be placed approximately 10' from the edge of present pavement. Pipes to be pushed where possible. Work to be done per the attached blue prints and drawings.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said conduit line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.

NOW, On this the 19th. day of August, 1929, the matter of the petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing; and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point within the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 15, Township 20 N., Range 13 E., running westerly and northerly to power house of the City of Tulsa within Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 16, Township 20 N., Range 13 E., crossing highways along the south side of Section 15, and north and south section line highways between Sections 15 and 16, and highways within Section 16, and along a part of the east and west highway on the south side of Section 16, a five inch gas pipe line known as Line J-18, and located according to blue print of survey hereto attached and made a part hereof.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.
